## ADVENT: THERE IS NO ONE LIKE OUR GOD - WEEK 2

Community Group Study: The God with No Beginning  
Gen 1:1; John 1:1-3; Col 1:15-17 | week of Dec 4

### OPEN

*Describe a creative ability that God has given you. What is one creative ability you lack that you would really like to have?*

**READ & DISCUSS** Read Genesis 1:1 and John 1:1-3. What obvious comparisons can you make between these two passages? What does this tell us?

From these passages, what conclusions can you draw about the nature of God - be it God the Father or God the Son?

Read Colossians 1:15-17. How does Paul describe the relationship between Jesus and creation?

**APPLY** Why is it important for us to understand that only God is uncreated?

What created things are you tempted to worship in the place of the Creator? Consider the three empty wells of 1) money and comfort; 2) relationships and sex; and 3) respect and success. Which of these is the biggest challenge for your heart? Why?

What sphere of influence or authority are you most prone to take credit for having created? How has having a creator complex in these areas diminished your ability to steward your influence or authority?

Describe a time that God reminded you that without him, you are nothing and have nothing. How did that time change your perspective?

How does recognizing that God alone truly creates free you to embrace human creativity without sinful pride?

## NEXT STEPS ...

*Continue to memorize and/or meditate upon Romans 11:33-36 this week.*

*Write a prayer to the Lord confessing a "kingdom" you have believed you created with your own hands. Ask him to help you remember that your value lies in who created you, not in what you yourself create. Thank him that he is able to bring something from nothing.*
