From **Proverbs 2**

1. What has been your working definition of wisdom up until now? How have you understood it?
2. Based on Proverbs 2 and the sounding passages, true wisdom seems to be practical, active, and moral, not only head-knowledge (note vs 8-11). Do you see evidence of that in Proverbs and Psalms? How is your concept of wisdom changing? How would you define it now?
3. Similar to the paradox of Philippians 2:12-13, our passage in Proverbs 2 has a paradox in that we are called to seek out wisdom, and yet it is a gift of God. What effect does this wise but real tension have on us?
4. What is promised in Proverbs 2 when we seek wisdom? (note the connections with verse 5 and 9).
5. Often times we can feel that scripture is not enough. Read 2 Peter 1:3, have you struggled to believe this or appropriate it in your life? How?
6. What further encouragement is promised in 2 Peter 1:4-8?
7. If you took this seriously, what effect would it have on your prayer life?

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
