QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. In 2 Timothy 4, the Apostle Paul speaks about finishing the course of his life and ministry. Reflecting on Paul's feeling of completion and faithfulness, what about your life? Are there things you feel like you have yet to finish that God has called you to do? Share about your unfinished godly goals and longings.
2. In 2 Timothy 4 we see that the Apostle Paul was concerned for the church to stay focused on serving God's word to the people. Before attending Del Rey Church, were you ever a part of a church that did not emphasize the Scripture and preaching it in context with care to preach Christ and the gospel? If so, share about the impact of being in a church that did not handle the Bible and true law/gospel preaching for the people. Share about how local church preaching has shaped your faith and life.
3. In our study we discussed the suffering of Paul in the ministry. In your own life, have you suffered as a direct result of serving in your church and/or sharing the gospel? If so, share and encourage one another through experiences of facing hardship.
4. In 2 Timothy 4:17 we read about how God strengthened Paul through hard times. Have you personally experienced God supernaturally giving you strength to make it through a hard season or rough relational/personal hardship? If so, share.
5. In 2 Timothy 4:5 we see Paul tell Timothy to do the work of an evangelist. In your own life, how are you doing at doing the work of an evangelist? How can others pray for your efforts and boldness in the gospel, as well as favor from God to see hearts opened to Him (cf. 2 Tim 2:25)?
6. What take-aways or reminders did you have from Sunday's sermon that you can apply to your life? Share and pray for one another for God's sanctifying grace in transforming us through the power of His word by the work of the Spirit.
