SERMON OUTLINE

Main Theme: The LORD our Holy God saves us so that we will be wholly devoted to Him and reflect His holy character in all of life.

1. Embrace our call to holiness.

- a. We must be holy as the LORD is holy (19:2).
- b. Holiness means devotion to the LORD (19:4; 20:26).
- c. Holiness means distinction from the world (18:3; 20:26).

2. Prioritize our Pursuit of Holiness.

- a. We must pursue holiness in our worship (ch. 17; chs. 21–22)
 - i. Holiness in sacrifices
 - ii. Holiness in spirituality
 - iii. Holiness of priests
- b. We must pursue holiness in our sexuality (ch. 18).
- c. We must pursue holiness in our community (ch. 19).

3. Remember the source of our Holiness.

"I am the LORD who sanctifies you" (Lev 20:8).
