

**Mark 1:29-39**  
**Jesus Came To Bring The Ultimate Healing**

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**Outline: Mark 1:29-39**

1:29-31 Jesus heals Peter's mother in-law  
 1:32-34 Jesus heals and delivers many.  
 1:35-39 Jesus partially divulges His true mission.

**Major theme:** Jesus came to provide the "ultimate healing," and the many minor healings are evidence that He has this authority.

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**Jesus Has Authority To Heal**

Mark 1:29-31 And immediately after they came out of the synagogue, they came into the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. Now Simon's mother-in-law was lying sick with a fever; and immediately they spoke to Jesus about her. And He came to her and raised her up, taking her by the hand, and the fever left her, and she waited on them.

Egeiro = often used in raising the dead

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### “Egeiro” Summary

Mark 1:31 Peter’s mother in-law raised to health  
 Mark 2:11 Paralytic raised to health  
 Mark 3:3 Withered hand raised to health  
 Mark 5:41 Jairus’s daughter raised from dead  
 Mark 14:28 Jesus’ predicts His resurrection  
 Mark 16:6 Jesus is raised from the dead

**Note: Jairus’s daughter’s resurrection is really a resuscitation!**

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### Jesus Heals Many

Mark 1:32-34 When evening came, after the sun had set, they began bringing to Him all who were ill and those who were demon-possessed. And the whole city had gathered at the door. And He healed many who were ill with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He was not permitting the demons to speak, because they knew who He was.

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### The Temptation To Make Jesus King

Mark 1:34 Demons not permitted to reveal  
 Mark 1:44 Leper not permitted to reveal  
 Mark 3:12 Demons not permitted to reveal  
 Mark 7:36 Crowd not permitted to reveal  
 Mark 8:30 Disciples not permitted to reveal

John 6:15 So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and **take Him by force to make Him king**, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone.

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### Jesus Withdraws To The Wilderness

Mark 1:35 In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.

Secluded place = "wilderness place"

Matthew 4:8-9 Again, the devil took Him to a very high mountain and showed Him all the **kingdoms** of the world and their glory; and he said to Him, "All these things I will give You, if You fall down and worship me."

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
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### Lesson 1

➤ We must realize that Jesus went to the "wilderness" to ensure that He took the crown of thorns first!

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### The Real Reason Jesus Came

Mark 1:36-39 Simon and his companions searched for Him; they found Him, and said to Him, "Everyone is looking for You." He said to them, "Let us go somewhere else to the towns nearby, so that I may preach there also; for that is what I came for." And He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching and casting out the demons.

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### The Real Reason Jesus Came

Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom **(for)** many."

Lutron = a price paid to set captives free.

Payment = Paid to God not Satan!

Ahntee = "In the place of" those who believe.

Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.

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### People Still Misunderstand Jesus

➤Sickness does not belong to you. It has no part in the Body of Christ. Sickness does not belong to any of us. The Bible declares if the Word of God is in our life, there will be health, there will be healing – divine health and divine healing. There will be no sickness for the saint of God. Benny Hinn (Rise & Be Healed!, p. 14)

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### Conclusion

➤We must remember that Jesus came in His first advent not to give us our "best life now" but to earn for us the ultimate healing.

Isaiah 53:5 But He was pierced through **for our transgressions**, He was crushed **for our iniquities**; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.

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
