Are you **following** Jesus?

People will be **terrified** at what they see coming upon the earth, for the powers in the heavens will be shaken. **Luke 21:26**

So when all these things begin to happen, **stand and look up**, for your salvation is near!" **Luke 21:28**

**Omniscience:** the state of having total **knowledge**, the quality of **knowing** everything.
