1. A teachable person practices **humility** **Luke 14:7-14**

a. **Pride** leads to humiliation **Proverbs 11:2**

b. Humility brings **honor** **Proverbs 29:23**

Proverbs 13:10

2. A teachable person demonstrates a desire for **growth**

Proverbs 2:1-4; Proverbs 22:17-19

3. A teachable person **embraces** discipline

Discipline is not **rejection**

Proverbs 15:32; Proverbs 12:1

“no **pain**, no **gain**”

Proverbs 13:13-14

4. A teachable person will take **initiative** **James 1:5**

6. A teachable person **inspires** others
