Three Displays of what it means to be filled with the Spirit.

1. Speaking and Singing

“...addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart...” Ephesians 5:19

2. Giving Thanks

“...giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ” Ephesians 5:20

3. Submitting to One Another

“...submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.” – Ephesians 5:21
