### **How to use Talk It Over:**

### **Discussion Questions**

- What part of the message stuck out to you and why?
- Read Ephesians 1:1-2, why do you think the Apostle calls the church SAINTS?
- Look at Ephesians 2:8-9, and discuss the role of grace and faith in your salvation. (Remember the canal analogy)
- What I.D.O.L.S. tempt and try to rob your worship or affections away from Christ? (I.tems, D.uties, O.thers, L.ongings, S.ufferings)
- What does the voice of condemnation sound like?
- What is an area of your life God is convicting you about?
- What do you need to TRY to better obey God right now in your life!

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### **Next Step:**

- This week take a few minutes every day to stop and pray. Be sensitive to God's spirit seeking to follow his convictions and to lead you to TRY and rely on God's grace to overcome any voice of condemnation or attack the enemy may launch against you regarding your identity as a SAINT!
