How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your Neighborhood Group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps.

Pastor Ryan's Main Idea:

“Go and share about God’s story of rescue and restoration”

Key Questions:

- What’s one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- How have you experienced the reality of a broken and fallen world as Pastor Ryan described and preached from in Romans 3:23 and 5:12?
- How did personally God rescue you?
- What do you long for God to restore in your life?

Optional Questions: If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- Who could you share this message with?
- With your Bible read and discuss Genesis 1:1 regarding creation.
- What Romans 3:9 and 3:23 tell us about sin regarding the fall of man.
- What do you see in Hebrews 11:3 and Revelation 4:1
- How is Jesus your rescue, I Peter 3:18, Romans 5:12-21
- What are some of the spiritual doubts you wrestle with? Have you overcome these doubts? Why or why not?

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Next Steps:

- What's one thing will you do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
