



Do you ever wish you could make a brand new start? You can. Jesus Christ came into the world not just to make us a better version of ourselves, but to make us brand new people. Join us in this 7 week series from the book of Ephesians and discover what it means to be made brand new.

1. Why don't people from different races, ethnicities, genders and socio-economic backgrounds naturally get along well with each other?
2. Read Ephesians 4:14-21. God's church is composed of people from all walks of life, different races, ethnicities, genders and socio-economic backgrounds, yet we have been made one body through faith in Jesus Christ. The question then is this: How do we live this out so that our unity is a witness? Let's find out.
3. In v.14 Paul says "For this reason I bow my knees before the Father." Looking back at what precedes this passage, (hint- Ephesians 1:1- 3:13) for what reason is Paul praying?
4. What specific things does Paul pray for in vv.16-19 for the church in Ephesus?
5. Notice the two reasons Paul gives in this passage for why he prays. Looking at v. 15 why does Paul bow his knees before the Father? According to v. 20-21 why does he pray?
6. Paul believes that only God's power generates God's love in God's people. Do you believe this? Does your prayer life reflect this? Does our prayer life as a church reflect this?
7. What impact would it have on you, your relationships, on Pathway, in the church universal, if you/we prayed fervently and consistently for God's power to generate God's love in God's people?
8. What changes do you plan to make in your prayer life as a result of this study? Spend time praying together for these things now.
