

JESUS OUR MESSIAH KING

Isaiah 9:6-7

I. Jesus our King is marvelous in how He came (6a).

A. He came in lowly humanity.

Isaiah 7:14: Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and **bear a Son**, and shall call His name Immanuel.

B. He came in lofty deity.

John 1:14: And **the Word became flesh and dwelt among us**, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

II. Jesus our King is majestic in who He is (6b).

A. He is a wise counselor who solves my confusion.

Matthew 13:54: When He had come to His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, **so that they were astonished** and said, "Where did this *Man* get this **wisdom** and *these* mighty works?"

B. He is a worthy defender who shelters me from fear.

Mark 4:39: Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "**Peace, be still!**" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm.

C. He is a watchful Father who showers me with compassion.

Psalms 68:5-6: A father of the fatherless, a defender of widows, *is* God in His holy habitation. God sets the solitary in families; He brings out those who are bound into prosperity; but the rebellious dwell in a dry *land*.

D. He is a wonderful comforter who soothes my conscience.

John 16:33: These things I have spoken to you, **that in Me you may have peace**. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

III. Jesus our King is mighty in what He will do (7).

A. He will rule completely.

Ephesians 3:21: to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus **to all generations**, forever and ever. Amen.

B. He will rule eternally.

Psalms 110:4: The LORD has sworn and will not relent, “**You are a priest forever** according to the order of Melchizedek.”

C. He will rule powerfully.

Psalms 110:6: **He shall judge** among the nations, He shall fill *the places* with dead bodies, **He shall execute** the heads of many countries.
